Grading

Grading is based on three criteria:

Complete do you address the key topics?

Clear is your audience able to follow along?

Engaging is your audience excited by the material?

Suggestions

An important aspect of your task is to determine which ideas are most important and how best to present them.

Examples are a useful way to make a concept clear.

Relating a concept to daily experience can make it click.

Pictures often capture a concept better than many words.
